



The way you drive says everything about you and SandRidge.

SandRidge expects every employee and contractor to adhere to the following safe practices:

1. Posted speed limits on all state/federal highways shall be followed.
2. The maximum speed limit* on dirt/gravel county roads will be 45 mph.
3. The maximum speed limit* on all lease roads will be 25 mph.
4. Excessive speeding will not be tolerated. Violations will be subject to the following:
 - First detection – Warning issued
 - Second detection – Commuting in company vehicle suspended for 2 weeks
 - Third detection – Disciplinary action up to and including termination(Violations are cumulative over a 24 month period)
5. Only “hands free” mobile devices are allowed while driving a company vehicle. Drivers must be in a parked position to make/receive phone calls. Texting or emailing while driving a company vehicle is strictly prohibited.
6. If a vehicle is stopped on the side of a county road, the passing vehicle must slow to a speed of 10 mph or less and leave extra room while passing.
7. If a vehicle approaches a non-controlled intersection, the driver must slow to 10 mph or less and ensure the intersection is clear before entering.
8. When approaching a narrow bridge, all vehicles must use extra caution to avoid a collision.
9. SD/LSI vehicles will use their headlights at all times to increase the visibility of their vehicle to other drivers.
10. When possible, avoid using county roads that have the following: full-time residents, churches, schools, businesses, etc.

* Speeds could be lower due to agency, county or contractual restrictions.
